

BRBFSC Guidelines of Skating Conduct 2009-2010 Season

To ensure a safe and positive environment for all skaters, we ask that you take a few moments to familiarize yourself with the following guidelines. Thank you.

- 1) Skaters **must check in** with the Ice Monitor before getting on the ice. If you are dropping in, you must **PAY** the Ice Monitor **BEFORE** taking the ice.
- 2) If you have a program tape or CD, please place it into the basket hanging down below the music room window before getting on the ice to insure your music will be played in a timely manner. Be sure to retrieve your music after your session is over.
- 3) When the Music Monitor announces your name to play your program tape or CD, **you must** put on an orange vest and **be ready to skate** when it's your turn. If it's a busy session and you **are not ready** you may forfeit your place in a lineup.
- 4) **Be aware of skaters around you.** Accidents happen when skaters are not paying attention and not using common courtesy to their fellow skaters.
- 5) **You must always YIELD to the skater in the orange vest.** The orange vest designates that a skater is skating to their program music.
- 6) Please refrain from congregating on the ice with other skaters, especially in the corners where others may be trying to practice jumps.
- 7) No food or drinks other than bottled water are allowed on the ice. Street shoes are not allowed on the ice as well.
- 8) Appropriate language, behavior and respect towards fellow skaters and/or adult volunteers while on or off the ice **is** expected.
- 9) **You must quickly exit the ice after the buzzer has sounded and/or the ice monitor has announced the end of the session.** You may stay on the ice if you are contracted for the next session and the Zamboni is not on the ice. **No one** is allowed on the ice when the Zamboni is out clearing the ice. It is **extremely dangerous** to do so.
- 10) It is expected of you to keep your area in the locker room neat. Please do not throw your items around so others have difficulty stepping over them. Please dispose of any garbage when you leave the locker room.

Following the above guidelines will help everyone on our club to have a **safe** and **fun** time while practicing and improving their skating skills!
