## **Ice Show Application**

*The City of Berkley presents our 34<sup>th</sup> annual Ice Show,*  
*“Legends on Ice”*

The City of Berkley cordially invites you to take part in our 34<sup>th</sup> annual ice show production – “Legends on Ice”, March 26 - 28, 2010.

### **Eligibility:**

If you are presently enrolled (or planning to enroll) in the Berkley basic skills program we welcome you to our cast.

### **Skills:**

We offer group numbers for children ages 3 and older, for levels beginner to advanced; we encourage all skaters to participate. You will be cast into a group number according to age, ability, and style. No tryouts are necessary. Keep in mind: You will not always be placed in a group number of exact age or ability.

### **Fees:**

- **Skaters:** \$165.00 for 1st participant in a family.
- **Multiple Family Participants:** \$150 for 2nd participant in family, \$140 for 3rd participant, and \$75 for 4th/5th participant.
- Cost includes production costs, ice-time, choreographer fees, a group number costume, show tights for females (one pair ~ additional may be ordered), & one family member pass to all shows.
- **Adult number** is available to adult LTS skaters: \$75 fee includes production costs, ice-time, choreographer fees, one group number, & one family member pass to all shows (does not include costume).

### **Parent Commitments:**

1. A parent (or other adult family member) must volunteer on two committees **AND**
2. Must work at least one time in the locker room as a dresser during a show **AND**
3. Must sell OR purchase an acknowledgement OR a charity table. Acknowledgements are printed in the program and can highlight your favorite skater or a business. Charity tables will be on ice seating with proceeds benefitting the charities of the Show Director's choice. Acknowledgement forms and charity table forms will be available in your first newsletter.

### **Deadline and Payment:**

- Deadline for applications is **November 1, 2010 (or October 1, 2010 if auditioning for a feature group – Basic Skills Freestyle Level 3 or higher).**
- Make all checks payable to the City of Berkley.
- Include TWO self-addressed stamped No. 10 business size envelopes.

# Rehearsal And Measurement Information

## Important Notes:

- Skaters are obligated to attend all rehearsals!
- Each group number will have 4 to 6 hours of rehearsals before the technical/dress rehearsal week. We make every effort to avoid conflicts between show rehearsals and your Learn to Skate schedule. A confirmed schedule will be included in a future newsletter.
- On-ice rehearsals will begin approximately four weeks before show week.
- You must review the ice show handbook thoroughly before filling out your application.
- Keep this page for your reference.

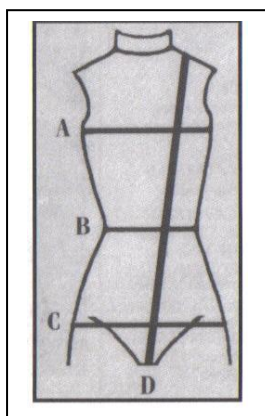
## Technical/Dress Rehearsal Schedule: Approx. times for "Technical/Dress rehearsal week."

Saturday, March 20	3:00pm – 12:00am	Opening Rehearsals, WORK DAY – Begin arena set-up
Sunday, March 21	6:00am – 10:00am 10:00am - 8:00pm	WORK DAY – COMPLETE ICE SHOW SET UP Opening Rehearsal, Finale Rehearsal, and group number SHORT rehearsal – ( <i>You may go home after your group is finished</i> )
Monday, March 22	4:00pm – 9:00pm	Section Technical Rehearsals & Finale Rehearsal
Tuesday, March 23	4:00pm – 8:00pm	Section One & Two – Full Dress Rehearsal
Wednesday, March 24	4:00pm – 8:00pm	Section Three & Four – Full Dress Rehearsal
Thursday, March 25	5:00pm – 9:00pm	Final Dress Rehearsal for ALL SKATERS (Show time 6:00pm)

**Family Passes:** One pass will be included with each application. Additional passes may be purchased for **immediate** family members at \$10 each. Immediate family is defined as siblings and parents and step-parents. You will need to provide names to the Family Pass Chairperson, Lisa Anderson, at a later date.

## Measurements:

Use the following guidelines to measure your skater. Measuring tapes are available in the basic skills office if you cannot locate one at home. We will also have posted times when a member of the sewing committee can take measurements.



- CHEST:** Measure your chest at the fullest part, and take the measurement in the front.
- WAIST:** Standing straight, measure around natural waistline; make sure tape fits comfortably around your waist.
- HIPS:** Measure around the fullest part of your hips and buttocks, keeping the tape firm, but not too tight.
- GIRTH:** With someone's help, measure from the highest point of your left shoulder, down between the legs, and back up to the left shoulder. (This will be your largest measurement – should be OVER 30").
- INSEAM:** Measure the inside of one leg, from the top of the inside of the leg to the floor.

- **I understand if my skater drops out of the show BEFORE November 1, 2009, a refund will be issued less 15% of the original fee. I understand AFTER November 1, 2009, NO REFUNDS will be given and my costume will become property of the City of Berkley.**
- I understand that my costume, music, choreographer, and group placement is at the discretion of the show director - I promise I will NOT call to switch or complain.
- I understand after a first absence, my skater may require a private lesson from the choreographer at their private rate.
- I understand the Technical/Dress rehearsals are mandatory for all skaters.
- I understand if any section of this form is left incomplete, it will be returned to me and I will have to re-submit it, possibly incurring the \$20 late fee.
- I completely agree and understand the requirements for my skater to participate in the ice show, i.e., parent volunteering, program acknowledgments, etc. If I am unable to fulfill these commitments, I understand that there is a fee of \$75.00, in order for my family to continue participating in the ice show.
